MPD: [2] 1. Armitage's Quindrew Archer, appealing type, balanced head, ample bone and substance for age, correct depth, needs to tighten in rear movement. 2. Proud's Jenevac Gentleman Jack, a little heavier all through than 1, lovely bone, strong neck, good depth, moved ok.

PD: [2] 1. Drysdale's Barleyarch Farthing At Drysika, quality puppy, lovely balanced head with adequate muzzle, true front, good feet and bone. Well ribbed with good depth, strong over loin for one so young, moved very soundly covering the ground well and at one with owner. **BPIS.** 2. Proud's Jenevac Gentleman Jack.

JD: [3] 1. Whiting's Quester St Pierre, strong in all departments, stood true, moved out well. 2. Ellis' Indijazz Originale At Soellis, nice type, balanced all through, would prefer him a little tighter in front movement. 3. Fairbrother's Madcap Purple Finch.

ND: [3,1] 1. Armitage's Quindrew Zazrak, just out of junior, balanced head, strong neck, true front with ample substance, good depth, nice rear, moved soundly. 2. Cure's Hillanhi George, handler did not get the best out of him today, good bone, ample body with depth, needs to up the ante on the move.

PGD: [2,1] 1. Hayes' Arkangath Mud Dauber, nice type, good head, ample bone and substance, true front, correct depth, strong rear, moved very freely.

LD: [4,2] 1. Roden & Mann's Valger Nearco From Keigame JW, lovely balanced head with correct length of muzzle, strong in front assembly, good tight feet, correct pasterns, lovely bone and substance, well toned rear and good angulation. He is full of power and covers the ground well. His handler was having to check him today which altered his stride slightly, would like to see him in a bigger ring. Pushed hard for top honours. 2. Hunt's Fleetapple Banquo, nice type with good front, ample bone and substance, well proportioned throughout. Stood and moved true.

OD: [3] 1. Adams' Sh Ch Barleyarch Alvar JW Sh.CM, a favourite of mine, loved his overall balance, well proportioned head with good muzzle length, strong in neck, lovely front assembly. Good depth and correct ribbing, strong in loin, well muscled rear with super angulation. Moved free with handler. **BD & BOS.** 2. Rose & Gaffney's Sh Ch Kavacanne Toff At The Top JW Sh.CM, quality type, balanced head, strong in front, lovely bone and substance. Correct feet, good depth, well ribbed, strong rear and correct angulation. Moved free and soundly, unlucky to meet 1 in top form. **RBD.** 3. Peebles' Keigame Super Duper Sh.CM.

VD: [3,1] 1. Pearson's Winterwell Benjamin Bunny At Ladyhawke JW Sh.CM, 7 yrs in lovely condition, balanced head, strong, true front, good depth, correct length, strong rear assembly, moved soundly. 2. Brown & Filby's Winterwell Babbitty Bumble At Desjiem, heavier framed than winner, balanced head, true front, ample substance, moved out true.

MPB: [3] 1. Trow's Winterwell Tootsie Roll, quality youngster, very feminine all through, lovely balanced body, true front with correct bone for age. Strong rear, moved soundly once settled, one for the future. **BPB.** 2. Armitage's Quindrew Aurora, nice type but needs time. Moved soundly. 3. Young's Trucklebar Anna.

PB: [3] 1. Trow's Winterwell Tootsie Roll. 2. Nixon's Quintana Quixotic, nice type, feminine head and expression, good bone and substance, well proportioned, moved soundly. 3. Young's

Trucklebarn Anna.

JB: [2] 1. Taylor's Wansleydale Pickled Pink, very feminine all through, good true front, lovely bone and substance, tight feet, well proportioned body with good rear angulation. Moved out well covering the ground. 2. Young's Trucklebarn Anna, very feminine and needs time to develop.

NB: [6] 1. Taylor's Wansleydale Picked Pink. 2. Nixon's Quintana Quixotic. 3. Armitage's Quindrew Aurora.

PGB: [11,2] 1. Beverley's Vinitas Little Miss Posh JW. 2. Peebles; Keigame Leading Lady JW Sh.CM. Two quality girls which have the same virtues, lovely balanced heads, good fronts, ample bone and substance, good depth with lovely ribbing, strong rears. 1 just had the edge on the move today, both very sound and could change places on another day. 3. Taylor's Wansleydale In A Pickle.

LB: [8,2] 1. Brown & Harrison's Gamebourne Bedazzled, very feminine and stylish girl, loved her overall balance, scores in head with lovely foreface and expression. True front, lovely depth, correct ribbing, short in back, strong loin, lovely toned rear with good angulation, moved free with purpose, covering the ground well and at one with handler. Could not deny her **RBB** & **RBIS**. 2. Trow & Jowsey's Winterwell Miss Tique, this girl has good balance all through, good bone and substance, lovely depth, well ribbed, strong rear, moved true and soundly. 3. Arrowsmith's Fleetapple Ophelia JW.

OB: [7,2] 1. Harris' Barleyarch Polkadot, well!! what can I say, she is excellent from all angles, feminine head with pleasing expression. Clean, strong front, good bone and feet, lovely depth and ribbing. Short in back, strong over loin and rear, super angulation, moves effortlessly, covering the ground with style, keeping good topline and tail carriage. A pleasure to judge, thank you. **BB** & **BIS**. 2. Rose's Sh Ch/Ned Ch Kavacanne Gift Of The Gab JW, well balanced throughout, scores in head, neck and shoulders, lovely type, very sound girl, moves freely with drive. 3. Elrington's Barleyarch Atora At Tequesta.

VB: [5,1] 1. Trow's Winterwell Miss Puddleduck JW 7 yrs in great condition, balanced head and body, stands and moves true with super rear angulation. **BVIS**. 2. Elrington's Barleyarch Atora At Tequesta, 7 yrs another free mover, in excellent condition, good bone and substance with correct balance. 3. Armitage's Hillanhi Jocasta Of Quindrew.

FTB: [1] 1. Nixon's Quintana Magic Time, balanced head, good front, ample depth of body, good angulation, moved soundly.
