## Judge Dogs: Mrs J Cule

Championship show - 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary: I would like to thank the committee for the very kind hospitality shown and also to thank the two hardworking stewards. A lovely entry awaited me to judge, a thank you to all the exhibitors. There were some lovely dogs to go over. My Open Dog class as the best class that I have judged for a long time. The standard was very high and the first five placings were all typical of the breed and so sound.

**PD:** [5,1] 1. Wright's Crumleigh Magic Max. A promising youngster with good head, neck and shoulders. Well bodied with a good top line and rear angulations. Moved well. **BPD & BPIS.** 2. Winser's Questor Chenas. Well grown youngster who seems to be at that in between stage. Would like to see more team work between handler and dog. 3. Morton's Goosepoint Bullion.

**JD:** [6,0] 1. Rose & O'Keefe's Kavacanne Toff N ready. Lovely shaped dog with the correct head and expression. Super sholder placement. Good body shape and excellent quarters, which he used well on the move. A sound free movement. 2. Gardiner's Benboee Barcena. Another dog which caught my eye. Good head and expression. Necks falls into well placed shoulders. Good legs and feet. Good top line, well angulated hindquarters and moved well. 3. Wright's Crumleigh Magic Max.

**YD:** [4,0] 1. Duncan's Magregor Montechzoma. A very smart dog of lovely make and shape. Good head and eye. Super shoulders, legs and feet. Good depth and topline and has the very best of quarters. What I like about this dog is his overall balance and sound free movement. 2. Gadiner's Benboee Barcena. 3. Fisher's Will I Am Of Ankherwood.

**ND:** [3,1] 1. Gardiner's Benboee Barcena. 2. Sutchest Snip. Quite a nice shaped dog with a masculine head. Good front legs and feet. Top line and depth are good. I would just prefer more angulations behind, which would then complete the picture.

**GD:** [5,1] 1. Duncan's Magregor Montechzoma. 2. Gardiner's Benboee Barcena. 3. Thompson's Redmires Class Is Class.

**PGD:** [4,1] 1. Hawksby's Delahawk Wild Rover. A lot to like about this dog. Super head and dark eye. Neck flows into well placed shoulders. Good front and body shape, and excellent rear quarters. His movement was sound and true. Lovely to watch. 2. Read's Wilholme Edwardian Dream. Pleasing head and expression. Good neck and shoulders. Good depth and firm top line. Well angulated quarters and he moved and showed well. 3. Wilson & Pearson's Ladyhawke Tamarind.

**MLD:** [2,0] 1. Hamilton & Waddell's Magregor Chocolossus. A super shaped dog with a masculine headpiece. Lovely lay back of shoulder. Good front assembly with the correct depth and well muscled quarters. Balanced throughout and lovely free flowing movement. Very nice indeed. 2. Scanlon's Isara Kurzhaar Ringmaster At Pedesion. I loved the head and expression of this dog. Strong neck and excellent shoulders. Good top line, legs and feet. Ample depth of chest and well made hindquarters. Moved well.

**LD:** [11,0] 1. Roden & Mann's Valger Nearco From Keigame. This dog appealed to me for his overall balanced outline and sound movement. Lovely masculine head and dark eye. Good shoulders, legs and feet. Correct depth of body and well muscled quarters. A dog with a bright future. 2. Terry's Pitwit Game Finder. This dog was so nice to handle.

Correct head, eye and expression. Good strong neck and top line. Correct size and body shape. Very nice flowing movement to watch. 3. Halpin's Torranpoint Basil.

**OD:** [11,0] This was the best class of dogs that I have judged for a long time, even in the pouring rain. 1. Harris' Sh Ch/Am Ch VJK-Myst Sterling of Barleyarch. Stunning masculine dog. So eye catching. You really have to handle this dog to fully appreciate his many qualities. Lovely masculine headpiece with a correct dark eye and expression. Strong neck and good front ensemble. His body shape and hindquarters are ones of power and substance. Can it get better? Yes it can! This dog is so sound on the move, his forehand and powerful drive is a joy to watch. **DCC & BOB**. Congratulations on going **BIS**. 2. Adams' Sh Ch Barleyarch Alvar. This dog was looking in tip top condition. Super headpiece, lovely dark eye and expression. Neck flowing into well placed shoulders. Correct body shape and nicely angulated quarters and moved sound and true. **RDCC** and **RBIS**. 3. Duncan's Sh Ch Magregor Pukka.

**VD:** [4,1] 1. Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Commitment. Quality dog of good make and shape. Pleasing head and eye. Good neck and shoulders. Well balanced body. Good top line and first class quarters. A sound free mover. 2. Scanlon's Sh Ch Isara Kurzhaar Invader Padesion. Correct headpiece with a lovely dark eye and expression. Good neck and shoulders. Firm top line and well developed quarters. He moved and showed well. 3. Staley's Jomeel Barty's Boy.

**SVD:** [3,0] 1. Thompson's Sh Ch Redmires Celebrity Star. This ten year old dog is a credit to its owner. He was presented in top top condition. Masculine head with a good expression. Good front legs and feet. Good depth and spring of ribs. Quarters well developed. Moved and showed well. 2. Hamlin's Isara Ybother At Nuash. Another dog presented in good condition. Pleasing headpiece. A well made body. Good top line for his age. Well boned, sound and steady mover. 3. Milligan & Perrett's Chevinlade Born to Be Wild JW.

**GCD:** [4,2] 1. Terry's Pitwit Game Finder. 2. Fisher's Will I Am Of Ankerwood. Masculine dog of good make and shape. Pleasing in all departments. I just preferred the quarters of the winner.

**PB:** [5,0] 1. Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Caribbean. Beautiful puppy with such elegance and good bone. Well constructed, good head and neck, good angulation. Best coat in class. Moved well. **BPB**. 2. Field's Deepthatch Pocona. Another nicely built puppy with good angulation front and rear. Moved OK. 3. Morton's Goosepoint Beluga.

**JB:** [6,2] 1. Taylor's Wansleydale In a Pickle. Very balanced youngster, good head and front, well muscled. Moved well. 2. John's Keigame Double Take at Frommesbeck. Nice head and neck, deep chest, good angulation. Good coat. Movement good. 3. Cox's Cushatlaw Blink.

**YB:** [5,0] 1. Beverley's Vinitas Little Miss Posh JW. Lovely shape, very well balanced, good head, neck and hindquarters. Very good coat. Moved well. 2. Allerton's Birkenwald Fable At Eshaldwell. Another nice youngster who is well balanced, good head, neck and hindquarters. Moved a little erratic. 3. Cox's Cushatlaw Blink.

**NB:** [6,2] 1. Taylor's Wansleydale In a Pickle. 2. Cox's Cushatlaw Blink. Nice head, neck and angulation. Excellent coat. Moved OK. 3. Hunt's Fleetapple Miss Millie.

**GB:** [6,1] 1. Taylor's Wansleydale In a Pickle. 2. Corrin's Eairycoreairykor Kara. ice shape, nice head, front and angulation. Moved a little erratic. 3. John's Keigame Double Take At Frommesbeck.

**PGB:** [8,1] 1. Haran & Waddell's Magregor Muffaletta. Lovely quality bitch, very smart, good all through, great coat. Handled very well. 2. Pearson's Ladyhawke Orinoco. Another quality bitch, good head and eye, good front action, which was lacking in quite a few. Good coat. Very close decision between these two lovely bitches. Thompson's Redmires Talk Of The Catwalk.

**MLB:** [9,3] 1. Harris' Barleyarch Polkadot. Beautiful bitch, clean cut, good all through. She created a lovely picture when standing. What a little showgirl, takes after her sire. Handled extremely well, **RBCC**. 2. Drysdale's Drysika Fleur De Lis JW. Sound bitch, lovely shape, good head, neck and topline. Moved well. 3. Mann's Valger Nerissa [AI].

**LB:** [11,2] 1. Gatcliffe's Allezweck Felicia. I liked this bitch very much. Well made with lovely head and neck, good topline, well angled hindquarters, need to be stretched out a little more. Excellent movement. 2. Brown & Davies' Gamebourne Bedazzled. Another nice bitch, lovely shape, good head and topline, good coat. Moved well. 3. Trow & Jowsey's Winterwell Miss Tique.

**OB:** [6,0] 1. Haran & Waddell's Sh Ch Magregor Chockywockydooda JW. Nice compact bitch, good head, neck and hindquarters. Good coat. 2. Rose's Sh Ch/Ned ch Kavacanne Gift Of the Gab JW. Another first rate, compact bitch, good front and hindquarters. Good coat. Moved and handled well. 3. Brown & Harrison's Sh Ch/Ned Ch/Lux Ch Gamebourne Perdita JW.

**VB:** [7,2] 1. Harris' Sh Ch Barleyarch Primrose. What a lovely neat bitch, oldest in class but didn't look it. Very balanced with plenty of substance, but very feminine, lovely head and expression, excellent coat, in super condition. She owned the ring. Well worthy of her title. **BCC**. 2. Elrington's Barleyarch Rattan At Tequesta. Another neat bitch who was not showing her age and worthy of her title. Pity she had to meet 1 today. 3. Squire's Sh Ch Winterwell Dolly Wagon Via Taftazini JW.

**SVB:** [4,1] 1. Haran & Waddell's Magregor Haranti. One I have liked in the past, very well balanced excellent coat, again in super condition, moved well. 2. Brown & Davis' Sh Ch Hillanhi Cassiopeia At Gamebourne. Nice bitch in good condition, lovely shape, good coat. Moved well. 3. Nixon's Quintana Tiffin Time.

**FTB:** [4,0] 1. Winser's Quester A'Chore Ghlais. What a gorgeous expression, temperament shone through, she begged for her first place, very well balanced, good coat, moved and shown well. 2. Nixon's Quintana Magic Time. A nice balanced bitch with excellent coat and superb movement. 3. Nixon's Quintana Tiffin Time.

**GCB:** [2,0] 1. Beverley's Vinitas Little Miss Posh JW. 2. Brown & Davis' Barleyarch Bourneville At Gamebourne. Good overall, good coat, feet could be better.

Best in Show was Harris' Sh Ch/Am Ch VJK-Myst Sterling of Barleyarch. What a showman. Lovely solid dog, nothing weak about him. Showed his socks off and was in full agreement with Jane to award him BIS. Reserve BIS was Adams' Sh Ch Barleyarch Alvar again in full agreement with Jane. A very well presented dog.
