

# **GSP Club Non Breed Specialist Judging Requirements**

*It is emphasised that the following criteria is to be regarded as the absolute minimum and inclusion on the various lists is at the discretion of the German Shorthaired Pointer Club Show Committee.*

## **Requirements for inclusion are:-**

### **List A1 (Non Breed Specialists)**

For persons who have previously been approved by The Kennel club to award CCs in the breed and have completed their first appointment. To have the support of the German Shorthaired Pointer Club.

### **List A2 (Non Breed Specialists)**

For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list and who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by The Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list and have the support of the German Shorthaired Pointer Club.

### **List A3 (Non Breed Specialists)**

1. To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed)
2. The Club would look favourably upon individuals who have judged a German Shorthaired Pointer breed Club Open Show.
3. To have judged a minimum of 10 Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate spread.
4. To have judged a minimum of 50 classes.
5. To have judged at least 200 dogs in this breed.
6. To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed.
7. To have attended at least one breed specific seminar in the last 7 years run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
8. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances).
9. Must have the approval of the German Shorthaired Pointer Club.

### **List B (Non Breed Specialists)**

1. To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed.
2. To have judged a minimum of 5 Open shows.
3. To have judged at least 20 classes, of this breed at Open or Championship Shows without CCs.
4. To have judged at least 65 dogs of this breed.
5. To have attended at least one breed specific judging seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
6. Must have the approval of the German Shorthaired Pointer club.

### **List C (Non Breed Specialists)**

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed, and have the support of The German Shorthaired Pointer Club.

*Note will be taken of prospective judges showing interest in the breed.*
