I would like to thank Three Counties Championship Show Committee for asking me to judge and for their excellent hospitality. It is a long time since I judged German Shorthaired Pointers in the Show Ring and although Field Trialling is my passion I truly enjoyed the day.

Many thanks also to the competitors for their entries, I was thrilled with both my Dog and Bitch line ups and I think I found some really excellent dogs amongst them.

**Puppy Dog** (4). **1 Marsh Hoad's Winterwell Sam Spade at Kilnrae** *BP*. A lovely puppy, good top line, well balanced throughout and sound on the move. I could not fault him on the day and he was so well behaved for one so young. **2 Coghlan's Soellis Smug Doug**. Another very nice dog, good coat and sound conformation. **3 Hooper & Brooks' Kentsteen Diemel**.

**Junior Dog** (2). **1 Thurm's Bryburn Bacchus**. A truly sound and well balanced young dog. Excellent shoulders and topline. Kind expression and strong powerfull hindquarters. I have no doubt he will be awarded his title. **DCC & BOB**. **2 Woolley's Fayemm Get Ready for Dunsa**. A very nice young dog. Good coat and topline needs to mature.

**Graduate Dog** (1). **1 Delaney's Redmires Ticket to the Stars JW**. He was the only dog in the class but no way could he be denied the first place. He is well balanced with a good top line and moved with pace and style.

**Post Graduate Dog** (5,1). **1 Milligan's Redmires Storm the Stars at Chevinlade**. A nice head and shoulder placement, good top line and correct tail set, very sound on the move. **2 Sielski's Orchidstar Wotsit JW**. Well balanced sound dog, plenty of bone and nice turn of stifle. Not settled on the move. **3 Hopkin's Seasham Don't stop me now**.

**Limit Dog** (1). **Adam's Barleyarch Ariat JW ShCM**. Everything to like about this boy. His overall conformation is balanced and sound. He covers the ground with a free and easy stride. Sure to go places. **RDCC**. **2 Bennett's Barleyarch Firefly**. Also a balanced and outstanding dog. I just preferred the presence of 1<sup>st</sup> placed dog on the day. **3 Stammer's Barleyarch Billbug at Lochpointer**.

Open Dog (11,1). 1 Whiting's Ranger Two Rodale JW ShCM. Well developed head, dark eye with gentle expression. Moved with drive. 2 Flaherty & Reddyhough's Sh Ch Isara Kurzhaar Wieser JW ShCM. Another very nice dog. Very good conformation, top line level leading to correct tail set and nice turn of stifle. 3 Harris' Am Gr Ch, Sh Ch Vjk-Myst Goeslikethewind of Barleyarch.

Puppy Bitch (8,1). 1 Heath's Winterwell Miss Marple at Pinseeker. I was told at the end of the day this is a litter sister to my Best Puppy Dog. I thought she was lovely and it was a close choice between them for Best Puppy. Congratulations to the breeder. 2 Ellis' Soellis Fannie Annie. Another very nice puppy with sound conformation and good reach and drive on the move. 3 Marsh's Kentixen Make a Memory for Kilnrae.

**Junior Bitch** (9,2). **1 Nixon's Quintana Qin Qiao**. A very eye catching bitch with a strong and muscular body for one so young. Good to see a firm second thigh, a deep chest and well-turned stifle. Very feminine. **2 Harris' Barleyarch Playtime**. A striking bitch. Lovely head and shoulders, strong neck well laid shoulders. She covers the ground with a free and easy stride. **3 Lockett's Fayemm Remember Me**.

**Graduate Bitch** (1). **Beverley's Bryburn Artemis of Vinita**. A very pretty bitch with a well-balanced body, a good depth of chest and spring of rib. She flowed around the ring with good reach and drive and although the only one in her class a worthy 1st place awarded.

**Post Graduate Bitch** (4). 1 **Sielski's Orchidstar Xyra O'live**. A very attractive bitch with a lot to like about her. She moved well with a good pace and style. I would like a lot more body with a more defined second thigh. **2 Hopkin's Seasham Dancing Queen**. Well balanced with a good topline. Good neck and shoulders, short coupled good rear angulation. Moved well. **3 Thompson's Redmires Bedazzled**.

Limit Bitch (7,1). 1 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track. This bitch is beautifully balanced when standing. She has a firm coat with a good depth of chest. So nice to see a second thigh. She moved with elegance to complete the picture for me. *BCC*. 2 Schoneville's Balvenie Bella JW. A well balanced bitch with straight front gentle sloping pasterns and correct rear angulation. She moved well with pace and style. I called her back for the challenge but not quite up to my 1<sup>st</sup> place bitch today. *RBCC*. Still one to watch for the future. 3 Hinchliff's Goosepoint Eiderdown.

Open Bitch (7,1). 1 Brown's Ch Barleyarch Tigernut at Graygees. An elegant bitch very typical of the breed. She moved with good reach and drive holding a level topline. I liked her overall shape and balance. 2 Lockett's Winterwell Bobbie Dazzler of Fayemm JW. A well balanced bitch with a good depth of chest and ribs well sprung. Moved with grace and style. 3 Elrington's Barleyarch Beetle at Tequesta.
