Minor Puppy Dog (2). 1 Burford's Kavacanne Morgan You Know, preferred head of 1 to litter brother. Better in rear movement and more bend of stifle. 2 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems, better muscled than 1 but not as good in front or rear angulation.

Puppy Dog (5,1). **1 Mann's Valger Quorum**, lovely puppy with all the necessary attributes. Well proportioned throughout. Lovely head, good reach of neck, good depth of rib, good angulation front and rear. Level topline kept on the move. **BP**. **2 Brown & Burns' Magregor Threesacrowd at Pothouse**, nice size, good proportions and a lot going for him. Just not as positive on the move as 1. **3 Burford's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems**.

Junior Dog (4,1). **1 Milligan's Jessophia's Oberyn Martell**, smaller than the rest of the class but best conformation. Well bodied, good angulation. Moved well. **2 Brown & Burns' Magregor Threesacrowd at Pothouse**. **3 Wilkinson's Zarazlinia Beinn An Oir**.

Under Graduate Dog (2,1). 1 Tudor's Indijazz Xperience at Brocodor.

Graduate Dog (3). **1 Hammond's Xsepshunall Merlot of Southmead**, nice outline and balanced. Lovely head, pleasing expression. Well muscled throughout. Good in front and rear. Moved with drive. **2 Cooke & Hammond's Seasham Super Trooper**, not as positive on the move as 1. However pleasing all round conformation. **3 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme I Gotta Feelin for Bessalone**.

Post Graduate Dog (4,1). 1 Scott's Alandrapoint Starry Midnight, very well balanced, nice head, good reach of neck, strong back, well angulated front and rear. 2 Powell & Tarrant's Malmelsa Romancing Romeo at Pawnic, well made dog, slightly taller. 3 Rose & Hunt's Kayacanne Gale Force Wind.

Limit Dog (5,1). **1 Marsh's Koolwaters Pacific at Kilnrae**, just preferred height and size to 2. Pleasing head, good depth of rib, good rear angulation which gave him the advantage on the move. **2 Duncan's Kavacanne Hun Toint Retrieve**, slightly taller than 1. Masculine head, Moderate neck, firm topline over well sprung ribs. Deep chest, well muscled hindquarters. **3 Coackley's Bach's Symphony**.

Open Dog (4). 1 Thompson's Redmires High Society, close between 1 and 2. Steadier on the move. Pleasing head of good proportions, good reach of neck. Good depth of rib, well sprung. Well angulated front and rear. *DCC*. 2 Flaherty & Reddyhough's Sh Ch Isara Kurzhaar Wieser, balanced dog with a lovely masculine head. Deep chest, good angulation both front and rear. *RDCC*; 3 Cooke & Hammond's Seasham Jumpin Jack Flash.

Veteran Dog (1). 1 Stedman's Indijazz Grand Designer.

Puppy Bitch (6,2). **1 Hayes' Valger Quartz in Elfrindew**, really liked this puppy and considered her seriously for BP. Very feminine but with plenty of bone and substance. Well put together and moved true. **2 Schoneville's Balvenie Bella**, just preferred the shoulder angulation of 1. Pleasing head with lovely expression, good depth and hindquarters. **3 Scott's Balvenie Buttercup at Alandrapoint**.

Junior Bitch (4,1). **1 Ellis' Soellis Dirty Gertie**, pleasing head and expression. Good depth of rib, good length of body, nice angulation front and rear, moved well. **2 Potter & Burton's Erinnerung Blaze**, nice head, good shoulder angulation, moved a little close behind. **3 Stopforth's Smilek Sleeping at Tal-y-Llyn**.

Under Graduate Bitch (2). **1 Potter & Burton's Erinnerung Blaze**. **2 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri**, good body proportions, with deep chest. Short back, sound on the move.

Graduate Bitch (4,1). 1 Hallam's Peersofdale Ranging Girl to Redic, preferred size and height to the rest. Well balanced. 2 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Sharp N Smart at Bessalone. 3 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri.

Post Graduate Bitch (4). **1 Hinchliff's Goosepoint Eiderdown**, a quality bitch with plenty of bone yet retaining her femininity. Lovely typical head, good neck and shoulders, well angulated hindquarters. One of the best movers which won her the class. **2 Gain & Dixon's Kavacanne A Vimto for Molkara**, lovely head, balanced throughout. **3 Stockley's Beljam Dream Design**.

Limit Bitch (9,1). 1 Mann's Valger Phoebe, well balanced bitch of excellent type. Good feminine head with lovely expression. Sound throughout with good front and rear angulation. Could not deny her her place despite being out of coat. 2 Lockett's Winterwell Bobbie Dazzler of Fayemm, another quality and well balanced bitch who I have always liked. Pleasing head with good reach of neck. Good shoulder angulation. Not as positive in rear movement as 1. 3 Duncan's Kavacanne Gale Storm.

Open Bitch (7,2). 1 Halbert's Sh Ch Valger Odessa at Marimay, I gave this bitch the RCC when I judged her last and she didn't disappoint today. So well balanced throughout. Beautiful head shape with lovely feminine expression. Good reach of neck into well placed shoulders. Good depth of rib, level back, excellent rear angulation. Covered the ground so well when she moved. *BCC & BOB*. 2 Thurm's Valger Odette, a lot of what I have said about 1 applies to this bitch. Again so well balanced throughout. Just did not move as well which cost her the first place. *RBCC*. 3 Squire's Sh Ch Taftazini Wilshee Win Too.

Veteran Bitch (2). 1 Attwood & Turner's Patterscourt Twill. 2 Gardiner's Kilnrae Gretel.
