## CRITIQUE - BORDER UNION AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY

**Puppy Dog** (4). **1 Delaney's Redmires Ticket To The Stars**, very smart 11 months dog. Good neck, well made front, quality bone & good feet. Short strong loin, moderate hindquarters. Covered the ground with purpose. Nice harsh coat; **2 Sielski's Orchidstar Wotsit**, just 7 months but a lot to like. I really liked his head, long neck & well constructed front & rear. Just needs time to mature. Moved OK but not quite the positive action of the winner. **3 Reed's Puddledub Pinstripe**.

**Junior Dog** (3,1). **1 Adam's Barleyarch Ariat**, this dog presented a very smart outline, good length of neck, well laid shoulder & good upper arm, strong straight front legs & standing on the best of feet. Well sprung ribs extending well back, strong loin, well made moderate hindquarters. Good profile movement; **2 Jackman's Navigareamor Hardtoport**, Res in Puppy, he is built on much more rangy lines & needs time to fill out.

Novice Dog (1). 1 Reed's Puddledub Pinstripe, just a baby as yet but I liked his front & rear construction with well let down hocks.

**Post Graduate Dog** (6). An interesting class. **1 Bennet's Barleyarch Firefly**, I preferred the elegance of this dog over 2. He is a moderate elegant dog, well constructed front & rear. Good bone, slightly sloping pasterns & good feet. Short back, well muscled. Moved very well; **2 Brown & Burns' Magregor Threesacrowd at Pothouse**, stronger built dog, liked his outline, & head which had a good length of foreface. Feet & pasterns not as good as the winner. Moved very precisely. **3 Mann's Valger Quorum JW** 

Limit Dog (5,1). Very close decision between 1 & 2, I preferred the head & neck of 2 but the easier movement of 1. 1 Smith & Reardon's Winterwell Foul Play, long muscular neck leading to well laid long shoulder blade. Deep well sprung ribs, short strong muscular loin. Moderately angulated hindquarters. Moved very easily covering plenty of ground. *RCC*; 2 Whiting's Ranger Two Rodale, loved this dog when standing but was just not moving as well as 1. Excellent head, well proportioned to the body. Well muscled & slightly arched neck leading to well constructed front. Good body, short strong loin. Well made & balanced hindquarters, he just needs to open up when moving to complete the picture. 3 Tierney's Puddledub Pyjama

Open Dog (7,1). What a nice class to judge, full of quality free moving dogs. 1 Harris' Am Gr Ch & Sh Ch VJK-Myst Goes Like The Wind, moderate dog, showing power, balance & shouts GSP. Balanced head, excellent expression, noble & gentle dark eye. Good well muscled neck, flows into well made front, quality bone, good feet. Well sprung deep &, short muscular loin. Moderate muscular hindquarters. Great positive mover, reaching out well in front & covered the ground with ease. Loved watching him move from all angles. Pleased to award him the *CC & BOB*; 2 Flaherty & Reddyhough's Sh Ch Isara Kurzhaar Weiser, liked this dog a lot, just lost out on front movement. Another dog with a classy head, good neck & well constructed front & rear. Strong loin, well muscled throughout, sound mover. 3 Thompson's Redmires High Society

Veteran Dog (0). No Entries.

**Puppy Bitch** (6). **1 Trow's Winterwell Inca Trail**, classy pup full of quality. Excellent balanced outline. Balanced head, sitting on long slightly arched neck. Well laid shoulders, strong legs & good compact feet. Deep well sprung ribs, short loin, well made hindquarters to allow her to stand over lots of ground. Easy sound mover. **BP**; **2 Thompson's Redmires Bedazzled**, smaller bitch but another with a classic outline. Pleasing expression & kind eyes, good front & rear construction. Well sprung ribs, strong loin. Well let down hocks which helped to give her an easy true movement. **3 Stopforth's Smilek Running Up Snowdon** 

**Junior Bitch** (2). **1 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track**, loved this bitch's head, expression & outline. Balanced head, good eye, long neck. Well constructed front & rear. Long ribs leading to short strong loin; **2 Garvey's Richtig Rah Rah**, another nice lady, good head neck & shoulders. Not as good feet as 1. Strong loins, well let down hocks, muscular hindquarters, harsh coat.

**Novice Bitch** (1). **1 Reed's Puddledub Pinchpenny**, 7 months baby, good outline, balanced head, long neck, well made throughout, just a shame she seemed to have eaten about 4 breakfasts!

**Post Graduate Bitch** (10,2). **1 Hayes' Valger Quartz at Elfindew**, two very nice ladies headed this class. Very classy lady, I liked her head & expression. Good long muscular neck flowing into well constructed front. Slight slope to her pasterns & good compact feet. Well sprung ribs & short strong loin. Muscular well angulated hindquarters & low hocks. Moved with an easy ground covering stride. *RCC*; **2 Schoneneviller's Balvenie Bella**, pushed very hard, just not quite the ribs of 1. I liked her head, neck good feet. Balanced all through. Excellent profile mover. **3 Stewart & Currie's Winterwell Dominique At Levagrad** 

Limit Bitch (6,3). 1 Elrington's Barleyarch Beetle at Tequesta, smart compact bitch. Balanced head, good shoulders & the best of upper arms. Strong short loin. Moderate hindquarters which she used well on the move. Harsh coat which was lacking in quite a few dogs today; 2 Cox's Cushatlaw Irresistable, I loved this bitch's elegant outline & movement. Balanced head with kind expression, muscular long neck. Well sprung ribs & long second thigh. 3 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Sharp N Smart At Bessalone

Open Bitch (7,4). 1 Lockett's Winterwell Bobbie Dazzler of Fayemm, very stylish bitch oozing quality. Typical head, good foreface, gentle but noble expression. Long slightly arched muscular neck leading to well laid long shoulder. Well constructed front, good body & muscular moderate hindquarters. Not as enthusiastic on the move as I would like but in the challenge she just did enough, pleased to award her the *CC*; 2 Pearson's Ladyhawke California Star, very smart bitch, liked her outline, good strong neck, well made front & rear. Ribs well sprung & long to tuck-up. Short muscular loin & very muscular hindquarters. Moved very well in profile. 3 Brown's Barleyarch Tigernut At Graygees

**Veteran Bitch** (1). **1 Drysdale's Drysika Fleur De Lis**, stood alone but she moved as well as any other dog today. Typical in outline, kind balanced head & good front assembly, good substantial ribcage, short strong loin. Good bones & feet. Moderate hindquarters, a well made bitch but still feminine.
