Many thanks to the committee for the invitation to judge, also to my two excellent stewards and to the exhibitors for a quality entry, with very few absentees. Temperaments were excellent and it was nice to see that movement has improved since the last time I judged. I was very pleased with my final line-ups and delighted to see my BOB win G2 and my BP win PG2. I thoroughly enjoyed my day.

**Minor Puppy Dog** (1). **1 Delaney's Redmires Ticket To The Stars**, really liked this 6 months puppy, good head, dark eye and appealing expression. Good length of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front, tight feet, short back, coarse coat, nice turn of stifle and straight hocks. Moved very well. Nit picking I would prefer a slightly longer muzzle but at 6 months he has plenty of time to develop, should have a good future.

**Puppy Dog** (1). **1 Adams' Barleyarch Ariat**, quality mature youngster very true to type. Presented a well balanced outline with appealing masculine head and gentle expression, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, excellent front, depth of chest, good spring of rib, short back and coarse coat, excellent topline and tailset. Good rear angulation, well muscled with nice turn of stifle and good width of second thigh. Excellent free flowing movement with good reach and drive. **RDCC & BP**. Delighted to see he won **PG2**.

Junior Dog (3). 1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems, nice shape and size 15 month old maturing well. Liked his head, good length of muzzle and dark eye. Presented a nice outline with good angles front and rear, moderate turn of stifle, tight feet, straight hocks and good tailset. Moved well keeping a level topline. 2 Burford's Kavacanne Morgan You Know, litter brother to winner. Another nicely balanced dog, flashy liver and white with masculine head, good reach of neck, well laid shoulders, good depth of chest and well sprung ribs. Short back with gently sloping topline into good tailset. Well angulated rear quarters with nice turn of stifle and well developed second thigh. Moved well. 3 Proudfoot's Keigame Dante.

**Graduate Dog** (2). **1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems**. **2 Brown's Pitwit Biddable Sapphire**, well muscled liver ticked dog with excellent masculine head, length of muzzle, good depth of flews, dark eyes and soft gentle expression. Balanced outline with good front and rear angulation, good turn of stifle, straight hocks, tight feet and coarse coat. Moved well keeping a level topline.

Post Graduate Dog (4). 1 Brown's Pitwit Biddable Sapphire. 2 Hamlin's Know No Bounds at Nuash, flashy liver and white dog shown in lovely condition, presented a well balanced outline, another lovely masculine head, dark expressive eye, good length of muzzle and depth of flews. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, depth of chest, nice bone, tight feet and sloping pasterns. Well muscled rearquarters used well on the move. Close decision between these two, just preferred head of my winner. 3 Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Cream Cracker.

Limit Dog (8,2). 1 Powell & Tarrant's Malmelsa Romancing Romeo at Pawnic, presented a balanced outline, lovely masculine head, dark eye giving a soft gentle expression. Good length of muzzle and depth of flews. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front, sloping pasterns and good feet, depth of chest, strong well muscled quarters with good second thigh, straight hocks. Free easy movement, with good reach and drive. Shown in excellent condition. *DCC*. 2 Duncan's Hun Toint Retrieve, another super dog again presenting a well balanced outline, masculine head and dark eye, slightly arched neck into well angulated shoulders, good return of upper arm, depth of chest, well sprung ribs and coarse coat. Well angulated rearquarters with good turn of stifle. Moved well on a free easy stride, covering plenty of ground. Close decision between these two, just preferred head of winner. 3 Stammer's Barleyarch Billbug at Lochpointer.

Open Dog (6,2). 1 Cooke & Hammond's Seasham Jumpin Jack Flash, one I have judged before, nice sized dog who presented a well balanced outline, with masculine head, dark eye and gentle expression. Good angles front and rear with good depth of chest and gentle sloping tuck-up. Nice coarse coat, strong rearquarters, good turn of stifle and straight hocks. Moved well on a good stride. 2 Serpa & Griffiths' Barleyarch Trumpeter, different type, medium sized dog masculine head with dark eye. Slightly arched neck leading to well laid shoulders, straight front, slightly sloping pasterns. Good depth of chest, short back, strong well muscled rearquarters, with good second thigh. Moved with good reach and drive. 3 Capener's Koolwaters Storm Warning for Alcazar.

**Veteran Dog** (1). **1 Adams' Sh Ch Barleyarch Alvar**, 8 years handsome quality dog who presented a lovely balanced outline, masculine head and gentle expression, well constructed throughout with good reach of neck to well laid shoulders, depth of chest and good spring of rib. Well muscled quarters and nice turn of stifle. Positive movement with good reach and drive.

Good Citizens Dog (3). 1 Brown's Pitwit Biddable Sapphire. 2 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri, lovely compact bitch with super feminine head, dark eye with soft gentle expression. Excellent coarse coat, short coupled with deep chest and well sprung ribs. Nice balanced outline, well muscled quarters, straight hocks and tight feet. A little unsettled on the move. 3 Proudfoot's Keigame Dante.

**Minor Puppy Bitch** (3). **1 Thompson's Redmires Bedazzled**, loved this 6 months puppy who insisted on giving her handler a hard time! Liver and white with a lovely feminine head and expression, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, nice depth of chest, short backed, lovely bone, coarse coat, well constructed throughout, when settled presented a well balanced outline. **2 Burke's Indijazz Sansa to Alcazar**, 8 months solid liver, slightly longer cast, pretty feminine head and gentle expression, well constructed throughout with good front and rear angulation, nice turn of stifle and good feet. **3 Davidson's Akansha Wonder Of You**.

**Junior Bitch** (1). **1 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track**, really liked this young bitch, who stood alone, but was well worthy of her first place. Super feminine bitch, shown in lovely condition, well balanced throughout, presenting a very nice outline. Lovely feminine head with soft gentle expression. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front and tight feet. Good depth of chest, gentle tuck-up, level topline leading to good tailset. Strong rearquarters and nice turn of stifle. On the move she covers the ground well on a free easy stride with good reach and drive.

Graduate Bitch (8). 1 Prior's Jolicoem Jevington of Whinchat, presented a well balanced outline, lovely feminine head and expression. Well constructed throughout with good front and rear angulation. Good depth of chest with gentle tuck-up. Slightly sloping pasterns, correct coarse coat. Moved well with good reach and drive, holding a level topline. 2 McDougall's Robincroft Charleston, another very nice well balanced bitch. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front, slightly sloping pasterns and tight feet, good depth of chest, level topline and good tailset, strong rearquarters used well on the move. Free flowing movement on a free easy stride. 3 Edwards' Kacela Sweet Imani in Jadenco.

Post Graduate Bitch (5). 1 Burford's Pingarypoint Hot Topic, a lovely bitch, super feminine head with dark eye and soft expression. Lovely elegant outline, good bone, well constructed throughout with good front and rear angulation, topline and tailset, straight front and good feet, coarse coat. Well muscled quarters with nice turn of stifle. Presented in lovely condition, moved fluently with good reach and drive. Well handled. In the challenge she pushed hard for the RCC. 2 Whitehouse's Kazanpaul Creme De La Crème, slightly smaller bitch than 1. Feminine head and lovely expression, good angulation front and rear, short coupled, level topline, good depth of chest and gentle tuck-up, strong well muscled quarters with nice turn of stifle. Good bone and feet, lovely coat. Moved well with good reach and drive. 3 Salter's Kavacanne A Sprite.

Limit Bitch (10). What a super class! 1 Rose's Kavacanne Blowin A Gale, lovely feminine bitch presenting a well balanced outline. Feminine head with dark eye and gentle expression. Good reach of neck, well laid shoulders and good return of upper arm. Correct coat, good depth of chest, level topline and good tailset, strong rearquarters and nice turn of stifle, straight hocks and tight feet. Powerful free flowing movement on a free easy stride. *RBCC*. 2 Duncan's Kavacanne Gale Storm, lovely feminine head and expression, well constructed throughout, balanced outline, good depth of chest, strong rearquarters, which she used well on the move to produce sound positive movement with good reach and drive. 3 Hammond, Cooke, Mould & Bird's Seasham Indian Sunset over Koolwaters.

Open Bitch (8). 1 Dawson & Walker's Jolicoem Lalique, quality feminine bitch shown in fit hard condition, very true to type, beautiful feminine head with dark eye and soft gentle expression. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front and tight feet. Good depth of chest, gentle tuck-up, level topline with good tailset and carriage, excellent coarse coat. Powerful rear quarters and nice turn of stifle. Presented a lovely elegant outline. Moved with good reach and drive on a free easy stride. Loved her. Pleased to award her *BCC* & *BOB*, delighted that she won *Gp2*. 2 Squires' Sh Ch Taftazini Wilshee Wyn Too, judged her as a puppy and she has matured into a lovely example of the breed. Feminine head with soft expression, well constructed throughout, with good front and rear angulation, good depth of chest and level topline, leading to good tailset. Well muscled rearquarters used well on the move. A sound positive mover with good reach and drive, shown in lovely condition. 3 Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Calamity Jane.

**Veteran Bitch** (3,1). **1 Gardiner's Kilnrae Gretel**, delightful 12 year old with lovely feminine head, dark eye and melting gentle expression, well constructed throughout with good depth of chest, well angulated rear quarters and nice turn of stifle. Her movement was sound and fluent with a well held topline. A credit to her owner. **2 Drysdale's Drysika Fleur De Lis**, lovely 8 year old with feminine head and gentle expression. Another well constructed bitch with good depth of chest, good front and rear angles and nice turn of stifle. Slightly longer in loin than 1. Moved well on a free easy stride.
