Minor Puppy Dog (5). 1 Heath & Robinson's Pinseeker Pep Guardiola. Promising young lad, went well for a baby. 2 Milligan's Greyelf Tarron, nice one but doesn't need to grow any more. 3 Schoneville's Orchidstar Themisto by Balvenie.

**Puppy Dog** (7,2). **1 Bowler's Winterwell Iggy Inch**. *BP*. Liked this one the first time I saw him he is so well balanced everything in the right place, correct coat, in hard condition and moved like a mature dog. **2 Taylor and Morris' Pelenrise All Guns Blazing**. A little apprehensive at first due to a fright he had at the weekend, however, he soon got over it and well deserved his place. One who should do well, movement was very good. **3 Schoneville's Orchidstar Themisto by Balvenie**.

Junior Dog (2). 1 Bowler's Winterwell Iggy Inch. 2 Mape's Agdenusher Mulberry.

Yearling Dog (2). 1 Dymond's Sh Ch Quintana Diamond Dust at Friarsbelle JW. This dog cannot be overlooked, he is in hard condition nice head, good coat and shows really well. 2 Stainsby-Soanes' Whistlecraft Jaeger. Nice youngster but needs more ring training.

Post Graduate Dog (3). 1 Taylor & Taylor-Morris' Pelenrise All Guns Blazing. 2 Hill's Ceilloch Russian. Nice liver and white moved well with a good topline. 3 Hamlin's Brocks Bouncer at Nuash. Good solid liver, beautiful head, coat first class, in tiptop condition moved a dream.

Limit Dog (4,1). 1 Peebles & Hammond's Seasham the Groover. S/l. He filled my eye at the first glance. Just my type, 1st class make and shape, lovely head and reach of neck, looked really well in the line-up, not enough tickets to go round. 2 Collins' Barleyarch Hoopla at Forestpoint. Another nice s/l dog who was unlucky to meet first. 3 Milligan's Greyelf Taelaros.

Open Dog (9,1). Open should be a good class and it was. 1 Stopforth's Taftazini Cesar Chance with Serenymor JW. Special Beginner Dog (2). 1 Bowler's Winterwell Iggy Inch. BSpBeg & BSpBeg in Show.

Good Citizen Dog Or Bitch (4). 1 Taylor & Taylor-Morris' Pelenrise All Guns Blazing. 2 Prior's Jolicoem Jevington of Whinchat. She is a nice bitch, lovely head and expression, one of the best movers today, unlucky to meet first. 3 Milligan's Greyelf Thessalia.

**Minor Puppy Bitch** (4). **1 Hinchcliff's Goosepoint Zsazsa Gabor**. Super compact s/l. This is a youngster to watch, her coat is a little soft at the moment, but this will improve, she is only a baby. **2 Hinchcliff's Goosepoint Gitta Gyenes**. Litter sister to first who is also nice and went really well. **3 Court's Magregor Seventh Moon over Ballyheige**. Another promising puppy to complete a nice trio.

**Puppy Bitch** (7,1). **1 Sielski's Orchidstar Missing Link**. A classy young lady, very mature without any coarseness. Moved straight and true. **BPB**. **2 Pearson's Winterwell Lulu Moppet to Ladyhawke JW**. Have always liked this one. Not quite as mature as first, but she is lovely and went really well, should have a bright future. **3 Staley's Jomeel Olivia's Choice**.

Junior Bitch (2). 1 Merritt's Sperant Chocolate Cosmos. Nice, honest bitch went well. 2 Bunker's Winterwell Little Itch.

Yearling Bitch (5,1). 1 Cox's Cushatlaw Athena JW. Pleased to award her the *RBCC*, won the class in good company. Compact make and shape, first class coat and moved really well, she will do well. 2 Trow's Fayemm Treacle Tart with Winterwell JW (AI). Different type from first, longer in loin, which isn't a bad thing in bitches, lovely dark eye, correct head and covered the ground well. 3 Nixon's Quintana Qing Ping.

Post Graduate Bitch (6,1). 1 Merritt's Sperant Pamplemousse. Nice honest bitch, moved confidently and true, lovely head. 2 McCulloch's Aytee Nualla. Quite a nice bitch, good coat, went well. 3 Hallam's Redic Shiraz.

Limit Bitch (10,2). 1 Trow and Jowsey's Winterwell Stoney Trail. Best of heads with lovely expression, well muscled all round. Very good hard coat, moved with drive and confidence. I was very pleased to award her the *BCC*. 2 Stewart, Currie and Boyles' Magregor Amourette avec Levagrad. Another good quality bitch in this class. Good angles fore and aft, good coat and moved well. 3 Staley's Jomeel Now I'm Here.

Open Bitch (9,2). This was a very good class. 1 Thurm's Sh Ch Dappledele First Date at Bryburn. A very nice head which runs into a strong neck, lovely topline and moved with drive. 2 Staley's Jomeel Naughtylicious. The only thing she was carrying a little too much weight but well deserved her place. 3 Squire's Sh Ch Taftazini Honour Wynna. Another quality girl in this good class.

Veteran Bitch (1). 1 Prior's Jolicoem Jevington of Whinchat. She is a nice bitch, lovely head and expression, good hard coat, one of the best movers here today. **BVB**.

Special Beginner Bitch (3). 1 Brudenell-Pryke's Puddledub Pilis. Nice Head and expression, good coat and moved well. 2 Sharp's Gartarcharn's Thistle.
