CRITIQUE - CRUFTS DOG SHOW

Veteran Dog (6). 1 Rose's Sh Ch & Ned Ch Kavacanne Toff At The Top. Have liked this dog since a puppy. Super head and expression, good coat and condition, moved with good reach and drive. In the challenge preferred toplines of winners. Proving to be a good sire. **BV**. 2 Coackley's Charmorloe Bach's Symphony. Very pleasing head and expression, not the front assembly of first, decent coat. 3 Tudor's My Little Old Man At Brocador. Losing topline now, not the balance of others.

Puppy Dog (1). **1 Sielski's Orchidstar Bonds Of Speed**. Very nice puppy, shows a lot of promise, well proportioned head with gentle expression, good feet and bone, decent spring of rib, very good coat, good reach and drive. **BP**.

Junior Dog (3). Good class. **1 Knowles' Wilholme Had A Lovely Time**. A really good prospect, taking his time to mature as he should, good clean cut head, lovely gentle eye and expression. Nicely balanced dog, well-muscled, held topline with a good jacket, good reach and drive. He needs another 6 months to a year and will go far. **2 Galloway's Alayglow Gamul Kebir**. Another super young dog, close up to first. Again a good prospect, just felt first had the edge on topline, good size and bone. **3 Cooper's Gameglow Top Gun**. Not the rear movement of others. Ok head and expression, lacked depth to chest and a shade long in body.

Post Graduate Dog (7). 1 Cook & Lamb's Brooke Will Do It Through Milcook. Best mover in this class. Nicely balanced head and expression, decent fill to body, holding topline, good coat and condition. 2 Spearing's Viewforth The Rodders. Larger dog, similar comments to first but not the balance of first, he could have gone better. Decent coat. 3 Reed & Tierney's Puddledub Pretender From Gistaro. Typy dog but lacked substance and bone, not a good tail, moved ok.

Limit Dog (5). 1 Rose & Hunt's Kavacanne Gale Force Wind. Presented a typical outline and good type, decent body proportions with decent spring of rib, nicely muscled behind, head ok, a shade harsh across the eyes, decent coat, moved ok. 2 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems JW. Not as balanced as first, needs to fill more in body, decent head and expression, decent coat, decent reach and drive. 3 Jackman's Navigareamor Hardtoport. Slightly larger dog, not as typy as others. Would prefer a little more refinement in head, decent coat, moved ok.

Open Dog (6). 1 Jedrzejczyk's Ares Z Wlodzimierzowa. Solid liver, moved best in this class, loved his type and general make up, good smooth gait with good reach and drive, decent coarse to touch coat, head was balanced with good muzzle but lacked definition at stop and eyebrows. *RDCC*. 2 Pastusiak's Way To Go Z Czarnego Dworu. A pleasing liver and white flashy dog, shown in good order with good coat, decent body proportions but more exaggerated in chest, moved out well, a good ground covering action, he was not as balanced as first. 3 Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Cream Cracker. Not showing so well today, head ok but a fraction too round in skull, moved out with decent reach and drive, decent coat.

Field Trial Dog (2). 1 Dymond's Int Sh Ch, NL, Lux, Bel & Dt Ch VDH/Benelux Ch Friarsbelle Marsh Mellow. Lovely balanced typical dog which ticked all the boxes today, shown in super condition, with a good coat, a dog that is fit for purpose, lovely head and eye, handler tends to run him a little fast but when slowed, has the reach and drive with smooth clean action, looked well in the Group. *DCC & BOB*. 2 Nilsson's Trubadurens Elmore James. For me, overdone in head, held topline when moving, coat ok.

Good Citizens Dog (2). **1 Marann's Spring Mist Over Booton**. Very pleasing type and sound, decent body proportions, moved with decent reach, coat could be better. **2 Prior's Booton Imperial**. Not as typical, was not good in rear and front pasterns could be better, ok head and eye.

Veteran Bitch (9). **1 Rose's Sh Ch & Ned Ch Kavacanne Toff**. Lovely girl, super head and expression, typy, good bone and substance, good coat, moved out well with good reach and drive. In the final four in the challenge. **2 Pitman's Pitwit Playing Games JW**. Another lovely girl, belies her age at 11 years, moved well and presented a very typical outline, super head and expression. **3 Glen & Shields' Wilcolme Saucy Brown JW**. Thought she would be my winner, but unsettled today, lovely type, handy size, typical in outline. Pity.

Puppy Bitch (3). **1 Brightwell's Pingarypoint Hot Chocolate**. Presented a typical outline, pleasing head and expression, good proportions, presented in super condition, a little bit unsettled but did enough. Good prospect. **2 Sielski's Orchidstar For Yur Eyes Only**. Not balanced, would prefer better angulation fore and aft. This reflected in her movement. Head a little plain just now. Well shown.

Junior Bitch (8). 1 Burford's Pingarypoint Legolicious. Won a good class, moved best in this class. Good type and nicely proportioned throughout, pleasing head and expression, coat of good texture. 2 Knowles & Glen's Wilholme Agnes Brown At Bessalone. I predict a good future for this girl, but had to settle with second today. When she is on her game, has that GSP attitude and shape, all she needs is time to mature and will fly. 3 Slack's Pingarrypoint Legolustrous. Again a nice girl, just would prefer a bit more of her, typy and classic in appearance, coat good.

Post Graduate Bitch (12). **1 Tierney's Ceilloch Crimson**. Presented a typical outline. Handy size, good bone, very good coat, pleasing head and expression, would prefer a little more muzzle, nicely balanced throughout, moved with good reach and drive but front coming towards, could have been a bit tidier. A good type. **2 Rose's Kavacanne Vixen JW**. Lovely head and expression, good proportions throughout, not the topline of first, feels she needs a little maturity and more developed at rear. **3 Ottaway's Nalapound Red Glory**. Again a lovely head with a gentle expression. Not as balanced as others today, but has time. Coat could be a little better.

Limit Bitch (10, 1). Good class. 1 Thomas' Brainescroft Saffron. Presented a very typical outline, good size and well balanced, short coupled, moved very well with correct smooth gait, coat of good texture, topline good, head was good but for me not that typical expression. 2 Gain & Dixon's Kavacanne A Vimto For Molkara. Close up. Lovely head and expression, good body proportions and topline. In profile goes well, but could be tidier in front when coming towards you, coat good, again presented a typical GSP outline. 3 Burford's Pingarypoint Eye Candy JW. Another good head and expression, longer cast, which affected topline, decent coat and condition.

Open Bitch (13, 1). 1 Dawson's Sh Ch Jolicoem Lalique. Lovely type, good size, typy, correct bone and substance, overall good body proportions, correct topline and tail set, super, free, easy smooth gait, best of coats, super balanced head with gentle expression, lovely eye, shown in good order. *BCC*. 2 Knowles & Glen's Sh Ch & Ir Sh Ch Wilholme Sharp N Smart At Bessalone JW ShCM CW16. Another lovely girl, unlucky to meet first on such good form, lovely free, easy movement, shown to perfection. *RDCC*. 3 Tait's Benboee Bordeaux JW. A favourite of mine. Super head and expression, lovely type, just felt she was looking her age in her movement today.

Field Trial Bitch (3). 1 Pitman's Pitwit Playing Games JW. 2 Fascella's Ouane Du Clos De Reve Daeor. Black & white, moved very well in profile, good body and bone, decent head and expression, coat was incorrect texture. 3 Pillinger's Witham Friary Maddison. Not the head of others, moved ok, shade long in body.

Special Working Gundog Bitch (1). 1 Fascella's Ouane Du Clos De Reve Daeor.

Good Citizens Bitch (3, 1). **1 Stainsby's Whistlecraft Go Go Gadget**. Solid liver, tidy, moved best in class, lovely head and eye, good shape, just needs maturity, good coat. **2 Whitehouse's Kazanpaul Creme De La Creme**. Not the topline or tail set that I was looking for, handy size, decent bone. For me, needs a bit more muzzle, decent coat.
