Veteran Dog (2). 1 Brown's Montalba Maurice, good topline and condition, well angulated to front and rear, well held tail. 2 Seaton's Peregrine Falcon of Seagunpoint, nicely made but not using angles to full advantage when moving.

Minor Puppy Dog (6). **1 Jones' Barleyarch Dubarry**, liked his overall shape, nothing coarse. Well laid shoulder and return. Good strength to bone. **2 Towns & Lay's Soellis Slick Rick**, very composed with good angles, pleasing feet and good depth of chest. Just preferred head of 1. **3 Adams' Barleyarch Ariat**.

Puppy Dog (4). **1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems**, I felt he had the best bone to body mass ratio in the class with balanced angles and good forechest. **2 Smith & Reardon's Winterwell Fowl Play**, finer all through and not using his rear angles to best advantage to and fro. **3 Roden's Keigame Nasrullah**.

Junior Dog (6). **1 Mann's Valger Quorum**, although smaller in stature this does in no way affect his balance or muscletone. He used both when moving and was the best mover in the class. **2 Milligan's Jessophia's Oberyn Martell**, there is nothing exaggerated about this dog, all angles are balanced and he has good bone to body mass. **3 Mervyn's Tomanipoint Celtic Knight.**

Novice Dog (4). 1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems. 2 Adam's Barleyarch Ariat, good make and shape, well handled. Just needs to settle when moving to and fro. 3 Burford's Kavacanne Morgan You Know.

Graduate Dog (2,1). 1 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems.

Post Graduate Dog (6,2). **1 Mould & Bird's Koolwaters Cream Cracker**, good size, pleasing topline between balanced angles. Lovely depth of chest and well held tail. Easy mover when settled. **2 Powell & Tarrant's Malmelsa Romancing Romeo at Pawnic**, pleasing head and neck with straight front legs. Would prefer a less steep slope in topline. **3 Hawksby's Benboee Beguiling at Delahawk**.

Limit Dog (7,2). **1 Cooke & Hammond's Seasham Super Trouper**, good topline when relaxed and well held in profile movement. Elbows well placed and he stands on good feet. **2 Serpa & Griffiths' Barleyarch Trumpeter**, well muscled but wider at front than 1 so front movement was not quite as tidy as it could have been. **3 Hughes' Sonnenberg Sealion**.

Open Dog (10,1). 1 Mann & Roden's Sh Ch Valger Nearco from Keigame, displays all the characteristics required by the Standard using his construction and balance to advantage when moving. *DCC*. 2 Rose & Gaffney's Sh Ch/Ned Ch Kavacanne Toff At The Top, a little finer in bone and stature but when warmed up his movement just nudged him ahead of 3. *RDCC*. 3 Graham's Sh Ch Winterwell Jelly Belly with Nyliram.

Good Citizens Dog (3,2). 1 Adams' Barleyarch Ariat.

Veteran Bitch (4). **1 Brown's Montalba Millie Chillum**, a very free and easy mover, she was a pleasure to touch and go over. One of the clean ones! **BV. 2 Gardiner's Kilnrae Gretel**, despite being 11½ she is very sound and easy on the move. Well angulated and in remarkable condition. **3 Dawson & Walker's Sh Ch Jolicoem Apache Tear**.

Minor Puppy Bitch (2). **1 Tierney's Keigame Hustle**, she took my eye in the ring, nothing exaggerated and so composed when moving for a youngster. Congratulations on your **PG3**. **BP**. **2 Sielski's Orchidstar Xtra O'live**, nothing wrong with this young lady either and I shall watch both their progress with interest. A pity they had to meet.

Puppy Bitch (2,1). 1 Tierney's Keigame Hustle.

Junior Bitch (9,1). **1 Hayes' Valger Quartz In Elfrindew**, good head complimented pleasing angles and muscletone. Good bone structure and body mass. No effort for her to move. **2 Mervyn's Tomanipoint Schumacher**, lovely make and shape when relaxed but in handling she tends to stand over her front giving her an unbalanced topline. Moved with purpose. **3 Smith's Indijazz Young Love at Abbeyaire**.

Novice Bitch (4). 1 Hopkins' Seasham Dancing Queen, a better shape and size for me. She moved well in profile. 2 Thomas & Taylor's Knabynnus Springtym Willow, longer cast but she has pleasing head and angles. 3 Fry's Waldburg Solar Eclipse.

Graduate Bitch (7). **1 Ellis' Soellis Dirty Gertie**, well balanced angles and good bone to body mass. Liked her head and ear placement. Lovely well laid shoulder. **2 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri**, slightly shorter in foreface than 1 but she moved very well both to and fro and in profile. **3 Burford's Pingarypoint Hot Topic**.

Post Graduate Bitch (5,1). **1 Roden's High High Jingle Bells at Keigame**, lovely head and neck, good strength to bone, pleasing topline, used angles well when moving. **2 Ellis' Indijazz Razzmatazz at Soellis**, a little longer cast than 1 but has good lay of shoulder and return of upper arm. Good feet and rear angles. **3 Thomas & Taylor's Knabynnus Midsummer Portia**.

Limit Bitch (12,2). My 5 placings in this class were so full of quality and could all change places another day. It was a super class to judge and none of you lacked anything specified in the Standard. Good luck to you all in the future. 1 Taylor's Wansleydale In A Pickle; 2 Rose's Kavacanne Blowin A Gale. 3 Mould, Bird, Hammond & Cooke's Seasham Indian Sunset Over Koolwaters.

Open Bitch (14,3). 1 Thurm's Valger Odette, correct all through from her lovely head and expression to the tip of her well held tail. A delight to go over and experience. Well done on you. *BCC, BOB & RBIS*. 2 Hammond's Sh Ch Seasham Lovestruck, nothing to dislike about this lady and she showed like a bomb. A pity I didn't have more CCs. *RBCC*. 3 Harris' Sh Ch Barleyarch Piper.

Good Citizens Bitch (3). 1 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri, in this class she was the best mover. 2 Schoneville's Balvenie Bella, good make and shape but not quite as fluid in movement as 1. 3 Fry's Wildbach Black Spellbinder.
