**Puppy Dog** (1). **1 Sielski's Orchidstar Wotsit**, a pleasing, eyecatching youngster with appealing head & expression. Excellent reach of neck & super forehand angulation. Well boned. Moved to cover the ground efficiently. Nicely handled & presented.

## Junior Dog (1). Absent.

**Post Graduate Dog** (2). **1 Jackman's Navigarareamor Hardtoport**, a lovely type. Scoring in head & expression. Great reach of neck. Deep chested. Needs time to achieve full balance. Moved on an easy stride; **2 Wilkinson's Zarozinia Beinn An Oir**, a neat package, giving his handler a hard time. Well sprung ribs & a good coat.

Limit Dog (5,2). 1 Whiting's Ranger to Rodale, this quality boy just gets better & better & he is now coming to his best. Classic make & shape with super neck & forehand angulation. Moved freely; 2 Begg's Alayglow Shubra, this girl looked as if she had a stiff neck, which affected her standing & on the move. Well boned & possesses a sweet head & expression. I do hope she is OK.

**Post Graduate Bitch** (6,1). **1 Hardie's Twechar Rosebud Forever at Mistyayre**, excellent coat on this solid liver. Nice size & feminine with attractive outline. Handled to advantage to take the class; **2 Arkley's Indijazz Show Girl**, thought she would be my winner but just threw it away by giving her handler a hard time at the end, when I was making my final decision. Has the most lovely head, eye & expression. Needs to be handled to appreciate her virtues. Soundly constructed allowing her to move with an easy gait. Limit Bitch (6,1). **1** Hayes' Valger Quartz in Elfindrew, have watched her progress with interest. Cannot fail to impress, she is from the top drawer.
