Pleased to see sound movement in the majority with no week hocks. Coats close fitting with a coarse feel. Just a few with a full eye and short in muzzle. A pleasure to judge your breed. Thank You.

Veteran Dog (1). 1 Smillie-Gray's Sh Ch Oakberrow Wotzinaname, dark kind eye, stands on good tight feet, firm topline held on the move which was sound and true all ways with elbows kept close.

Minor Puppy Dog (0). No Entries

**Puppy Dog** (3,1). **1 Milligan's Redmires Storm The Stars**, more collected on the move than 2, very clean front assembly has good forward reach, very sound on handling carries ample body for age, pleasing picture throughout. **2 Delaney's Redmires Ticket To The Stars**, bone and feet very good, has a clean arched length of neck, compact body, with flowing topline moved with drive although a little unsettled.

**Junior Dog** (3,1). **1 Adams Barleyarch Ariat**, shows and handled to advantage, liked his headpiece carries a good length of rib I'm sure will mature on, stands over his ground and moves with a long free active gait, a sound young chap. **2 Proudfoot's Keigame Dante**, moved out quite well was true both ways just needs to settle a little, has a good spring of rib, stands on tight arched feet.

Novice Dog (1) 1 Milligan's Redmires Storm The Stars.

Post Graduate Dog (2). 1 Bennett's Barleyarch Firefly, very collected on the move, lovely free action with excellent front extension, not exaggerated, slight slope to pasterns, liked his clean cut balanced head with kind eye, a sound chap. 2 Rose's Kavacanne Morgan It Seems, again this chap has a lovely balanced headpiece, shown in condition super muscletone, with width in rear quarters, ample substance in body, length of neck flows cleanly through lay of shoulder to firm backline, may be not quite as fluid in action as Storm, but a close call.

Limit Dog (8,2). 1 Powell & Tarrant's Malmelsa Romancing Romeo at Pawnic, out moved the class with his very true and balanced action keeping his stylish profile at all times, head pleased lovely finish of muzzle with wide open nostrils, sound on handling this very honest male. 2 Whiting's Ranger Two Rodale, much to like, he has a very kind expression, well bodied up, to strength of loin, good width in rear quarters, covers his ground well in profile movement, very much in proportion throughout. 3 Grant's Goosepoint Dipper from Stairfoot.

Open Dog (8,2). 1 Lisle's Sh Ch Barleyarch Rolex. DCC & BOB. Upstanding male, fully mature excellent profile, liked his head, eye and expression, clean lines throughout, kept himself together on the move giving a positive ground covering action with a very positive drive from rear quarters, gave a picture of true GSP type. 2 Harris' Am Gr Ch & Sh Ch Vjk-Myst Goeslikethewind of Barleyarch, he excels with his sound and balanced construction, handled to give his best, he moves true, elbows kept tight to body, when free standing very clean front assembly, shown in condition. 3 Serpa & Griffiths' Barleyarch Trumpeter.

Good Citizens Dog (2). 1 Brown's Pitwit Biddable Sapphire, carries a balanced outline. Compact in body clean front assembly was tidy on the move. 2 Prior's Booton Imperial, stronger in head good open nostrils straight bone, ample substance in body with spring of rib.

Veteran Bitch (2). 1 Glen & Shields' Wilholme Saucy Brown, both of these strode out well, she has length of neck, good proportions in body and length of rib, to well angulated quarters. 2 Gardiner's Kilnrae Gretel, excellent for her 12 years, lovely free striding action so tight and clean coming towards, a pleasure to judge.

Minor Puppy Bitch (5). 1 Trow's Winterwell Inca Trial, went on to take *BP*. I thought her to be of excellent quality and type. Super fore hand with no exaggeration of lift just a true extension, lovely co-ordination & and foot fall for one so young, shows much promise. 2 Burford's Pingarypoint Eye Candy, just needs to settle to her task, lovely tight arched feet she handles well, moved out with a good action, clean front assembly, ample rib for age, good angulation in rear quarters. 3 Mellor & Heath's Winterwell Inca Gold to Evagrove.

Puppy Bitch (7,1). 1 Trow's Winterwell Inca Trial. 2 Burford's Pingarypoint Eye Candy. 3 Thompson's Redmires Bedazzled.

Junior Bitch (3). 1 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track, when she settled she moved with a positive and true action, I liked her in head and eye, super bone and feet, has length of neck depth in body, topline held on the move, a sound bitch all through, with a very balanced outline. 2 Tierney's Keigame Hustle, well proportioned headpiece, good lay of shoulder, clean arched neck, to firm backline, liked her width in rear quarters, used well on the move. 3 Taylor's Knabynnus Aurora Borealis.

Novice Bitch (1). 1 Trow's Winterwell Inca Trial.

Post Graduate Bitch (8,1). 1 Whitehouse's Kazanpaul Crème De La Crème, won a mixed class. She was shown to advantage, good bone with slight slope to pasterns, tight well shaped feet, balanced proportions, gave a solid and free action. 2 Tierney's Puddledub Pour Moi, slightly taller bitch, pleased in head and eye, good length of neck carries a good length of rib with ample substance in rear quarters, was steady on the move. 3 Schoneville's Balvenie Bella.

Limit Bitch (9,2). 1 Hinchliff's Goosepoint Eiderdown, put down in great condition of coat, body and muscletone. Pleased me all through, lovely almond shape eye expression and head proportions very good, came together on the move giving a very positive free flowing action. In stance has the make and shape of good breed type. My pleasure to award her the *RBCC*. 2 Knowles & Glenn's Wilholme Sharp N Smart at Bessalone, again this bitch handles really well, with much to like, clean lay of shoulder good neck length flows smoothly to level topline, goes with a very positive driving action, elbows tight giving a clean front stance with good forechest, pleased on the move. 3 Burford's Pingarypoint Hot Topic.

**Open Bitch** (9,2). **1 Trow's Sh Ch Winterwell Tootsie Roll**, delighted to award this bitch the *BCC*. I thought her of outstanding merit. Won in good company. For me her outline in stance and movement plus her foot fall was a joy to see. **2 Squire's Sh Ch Taftazini Wilshee Wyn Too**, maybe a little slighter made but gives a true and balanced picture, scores on the move being sound and ground covering, carries no exaggerations, she has a most pleasing headpiece, a pleasure to judge, shown in condition. **3 Rose's Kavacanne Blowin A Gale**, a trio of good bitches.

**Good Citizens Bitch** (2). **1 Gardiner's Malmelsa Flirty Fleuri**, a tad over weight kind eye, well bodied good straight bone with tight arched feet. Steady movement. **2 Fry's Wildbach Black Spellbinder**, a bitch of substance, dark kind eye, good depth of body, width in rear quarters.
