Thank**Veteran Dog** (2). **1 Drysdale's Sh Ch Barleyarch Farthing At Drysika JW ShCM**. Well. this dog for me just shouts GSP. Honest lad with no exaggeration and everything in the right place. Super head with a lovely eye and good ear set. Muscular neck with well laid shoulders, excellent front assembly, correct bone and feet. Super depth and spring of rib with a firm topline and excellent coat. Rounded quarters and well muscled second thigh. He never put a food wrong today with his sound positive movement. **DCC**. **2 Tudor's My Little Old Man At Brocador**. Pleasing size and of good make and shape throughout. Balanced head, best of legs and feet, good depth and body, sound mover.

Minor Puppy Dog (3). **1 Brown's Graygees Gigolo**. Promising puppy and of a lovely type, compact with a well balanced head. Very clean over his neck and shoulders, straight in front, good feet and correct bone, excellent depth of chest for his age, correct topline and tailset, good bend of stifle. Moved well for one so young. **2 Braine's Grenetrest Canterbury Bell**. Another promising baby, good head and eye, best of legs and feet, lovely spring of rib, well rounded hindquarters. Sound on the move. **3 Stedman's Indijazz Designer Genes**.

Puppy Dog (4). 1 Dockwray's Yockletts Solstice. This youngster is very well constructed throughout and has a super masculine head but shows no sign of coarseness. Lovely over the neck and shoulders with a good straight front with plenty of heart room, super depth and body with a firm topline that he keeps on the move, correct bone, well developed quarters, sound fore and aft. *BPD*. 2 Sielski's Orchidstar Bonds Of Speed. Balanced head with a good reach of neck onto well laid shoulders. Pleasing front with the best of legs and feet. Firm well muscled body, nicely sprung ribs and well angulated hindquarters. Not as positive in front movement as the winner on the day. 3 Newcombe's Heathermark Sorrel.

Junior Dog (2). **1 Stopforth's Taftazini Cesar Chance**. Lovely size of dog with a pleasing outline. Best of heads with a good eye and soft expression. Excellent reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Best of fronts, well sprung ribs and lovely depth. Short compact body and a pleasing bend of stifle. So sound on the move with good reach and drive. **2 Hooper & Brooks' Kentsteen Diemel**. Lovely type with a good head and eye, very clean over the neck and shoulders, well developed body, correct topline and tailset and well rounded quarters. Could not match the winner on movement.

Yearling Dog (4). 1 Hinchliff's Goosepoint Gloster Grebe (Al) JW. This young dog is so typical in head and has the kindest of expression. Scores in neck and shoulders, very good depth of chest, straight in front with excellent bone and substance throughout. Short in back with a firm topline and correct coat. Strong muscular hindquarters, sound positive mover with super reach and drive, presented in superb order. *RDCC*. 2 Stopforth's Taftazini Cesar Chance. 3 Staley's Jomeel Monkey Wrench.

Novice Dog (2). **1 Dockwray's Yockletts Solstice**. **2 Cooper's Gameglow Top Gun**. Liked his type but just needs time. Nicely balanced, good head, strong neck, straight front, well bodied with lovely depth and substance, moved well.

Post Graduate Dog (4). **1 Delaney's Redmires Ticket To The Stars**. Lots to like about this chap, well balanced, very typical head, with a kind eye and soft expression. Very clean over his neck and shoulders. Correct topline and tailset, well muscled quarters with good bend of stifle. Sound on the move. **2 Thomas' Brainescroft Tahiti**. Very good type, balanced head, pleasing reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Straight in front, excellent bone and substance. Good legs and feet, lovely depth of chest with plenty of heart room, strong muscular hindquarters. **3 Staley's Jomeel Midnight Rambler**.

Limit Dog (4). 1 Bennett's Barleyarch Firefly. What a lovely dog to go over with a very typical outlook. Balanced head with a kind eye and correct ear set. Strong neck, lovely straight front with plenty of heart room. Well developed body with good depth and substance. Firm topline with an excellent coat. Well rounded quarters with a lovely width of thigh. Sound positive mover. 2 Hamlin's Know No Bounds At Naush JW. Super type of dog who I have done well before but disappointed me on the move today, not as steady as the winner. Masculine head with a lovely expression. Good over his neck and shoulders, super bone and substance with plenty of heart room. Excellent spring of rib, depth and coat, Firm topline with well rounded quarters and lovely width of thigh. 3 Sielski's Orchardstar Wotsit

Open Dog (10,1). Quality class with some top class exhibits. 1 Brown & Burns' Sh Ch Magregor Threesacrowd At Pothouse JW ShCM. Favourite of mine who I have done very well before, and an excellent example of the breed. Best of heads with a lovely dark eye and soft expression, very clean over the neck and shoulders, short backed, straight in front, plenty of heart room, well sprung ribs, well angulated hindquarters. When settled moved with good reach and drive, close up for top honours. 2 Adams' Sh Ch Barleyarch Ariat. Another quality dog from this kennel. Balanced outlook with a good head and kind eye with correct earset. Lovely over his neck and shoulders. Plenty of depth and substance, correct bone, firm topline and correct tail set. Pleasing bend of stifle. Moved steady. 3 Gatliffe's Allezweck Shamrock.

Special Beginner Dog (1). 1 Stopforth's Taftazini Cesar Chance. BSB

Special Beginner Bitch (1). 1 McCulloch's Winterwell Oh So Sharp. Almost 8 months, and has a lovely feminine head and soft expression. Lovely reach of neck onto well laid shoulders. Nice front and good body and depth for age. Correct bone and firm topline. Moved well.

Veteran Bitch (1). **1 Pudney's Stairfoot Skye**. Just loved the head on this bitch so balanced with plenty of work in it and a kind eye and best of expressions. Good front assembly with ample heart room, correct bone and well developed quarters. Lovely sound mover.

Minor Puppy Bitch (4). 1 Desombre's Braneath Ptarmigan. Headed a class of four lovely puppies all at different stages of their development. This bitch caught my eye as is so balanced with a lovely head and expression. Good reach of neck onto well placed shoulders, lovely bone and depth. Straight in front with good spring of rib. Super width of thigh. Moved out well for age. 2 Hayne's Graygees Skyhawk. Another promising baby but not as mature as first. Lovely head and eye, well laid shoulders, nice front with super depth for age. Good spring of rib, pleasing quarters. Moved well. 3 Rittscher's Zakova Amrone.

Puppy Bitch (12,4). 1 Greenfield's Eastfalla Three Times A Lady. Super young lady and so well made throughout. Feminine head with plenty of work in it, soft expression and correct ear set. Clean over her neck and shoulders. Lovely front assembly with excellent depth for her age and plenty of heartroom. Excellent substance, best of coats, correct tail set and well rounded quarters with good width of thigh. Moved with excellent reach and drive. *BP*. 2 Izard's Yockletts Cordiale. Another quality puppy who shows much promise. Different type to one but so well balanced and presents a very typical outlook. Pretty head and kind expression. Lovely over her neck and shoulders. Good front, correct bone, and pleasing depth and substance. Firm topline and a good bend of stifle. Moved out well. 3 Burke's Alcazar After Eight.

Junior Bitch (5). **1Barleyarch Skye At Longbarrow**. Lovely girl and is so well balanced throughout. Best of heads with a lovely eye and expression. Good reach of neck, well laid shoulders, straight front with correct bone, depth and substance. Good width of thigh with lovely bend of stifle. Free and easy mover. **2 Rumney's Kacela Sweet Ayana**. Feminine bitch with a pleasing outlook. Lovely balanced head and eye, excellent layback of shoulders, correct bone, well developed body and firm topline. Well rounded quarters. Move so soundly. **3 Burford's Pingarypoint Legolicious**.

Yearling Bitch (6,5). **1 Stainsby Soanes' Whistlecraft Go Go Gadget**. This bitch is so well constructed throughout. Loved her head, balanced with a very classic outlook. Good reach of neck, excellent layback of shoulder, correct bone and feet. Good front assembly. Strong firm topline and excellent coat. Good width of quarters, very sound on the move. Still more to come from this bitch. **2 Burford's Pingarypoint Legolicious**. Nice size of girl with a pleasing head and expression, lovely bone and substance good depth of chest and well rounded quarters. Moved steadily once she got into her stride. **3 Hustler's Ayteen Katerina**.

Novice Bitch (5). **1 Squires' Taftazini Honour Wynna**. Well developed girl for her age. Balanced head with plenty of work in it and a lovely expression. Clean over her neck and shoulders with a well made front and lovely bone and substance throughout. Good depth, excellent well rounded quarters, very sound on the move. **2 Stainsby-Soanes' Whistlecraft Go Go Gadget**. **3 Izard's Yockletts Cordiale**.

Post Graduate Bitch (3). 1Jones' Barleyarch Fairplay (AI). Loved the overall balance of this bitch. Feminine with super strength and substance, not overdone in any way. Best of heads, clean over her neck and shoulders with a good front assembly. Plenty of depth with a lovely spring of rib, firm topline, correct coat and tailset. Well muscled quarters with a good width of thigh. Moved with super reach and drive. *RBCC*. 2 Stammer's Deena Ballettanzer At Lochpointer. Good size of bitch who is well balanced throughout, feminine head with the best of expressions, good neck and shoulders, lovely depth and spring of rib, good bend of stifle. Moved soundly. 3 Milliagan's Isara Kurzhaar All Spice.

Limit Bitch (10,9). 1 Haran & Waddell's Magregor Sneeball. This quality bitch was just what I was looking for. Built on clean lines, she has a beautifully balanced head with a kind dark eye and best of expression. Scored in neck and shoulders with correct front assembly and super depth with plenty of heart room. Lovely bone throughout with a good spring of rib and a firm topline. Excellent coat and correct tailset, well rounded quarters and a lovely width of thigh. Shown in tip top condition. Moved soundly on a free and easy stride. BCC & BOB. 2 Burford's Pingarypoint Eye Candy JW. A well balanced girl of good size and presents a pleasing outline. Sweet feminine head with a well made front, lovely reach of neck onto well laid shoulders and good depth throughout. Correct topline, good tailset, nicely rounded quarters and a sound mover. 3 Drysdale's Drysika Fast Track.

Open Bitch (5,1). 1 Elliott's Int, NI & Vdh Ch Gamebourne Enchanted With Ankerwycke. A beautifully put together girl who won this class on her excellent conformation combined with her very typical outlook. No exaggeration here, plenty of bone and substance but still is very feminine throughout. Super head and expression, good reach of neck with well laid shoulders, firm topline with strong well muscled quarters, moved soundly with excellent reach and drive. 2 Burford's Pingarypoint Hot Topic. Another very well put together bitch who won her place on her overall construction, a lovely type. Balanced head, clean over her neck and shoulders. Straight front, correct bone and feet. Well rounded hindquarters. Soundest of movers. 3 Schoneville's Balvenie Midnight Rambler ShCM.
