SBD/B (5) 1st Richtig Razzle Me Pink (Miss A Vidamour) 13m of ex type and style; this promising bitch had a clean cut head; ex skull, ear, eye and muzzle; had depth with freedom at upper arm; relatively short back; width to muscled rear; absolutely sound on ex feet with long low strides; one to watch as she simply matures along these same lines BSB 2nd Aytee Quince (Mrs Tanya Mingo) rising 14m bitch of graceful lines; well angulated; well ribbed back and deep through; clean fronted; clean in head with ex eye & ear; just moved away rather cowhocked with the wet ground and a touch of uncertainty playing its part; correct in tuck up and nicely short coated, low forward reach, another youngster to watch 3rd Kavacanne Pina Colada of Patterscourt (Mrs and Miss Attwood and Turner) VB (2) Sh Ch Barleyarch Skye at Longbarrow (Mr M & Mrs B Blay) Fabulous headed 7 yrs that I felt privileged to go over given her classic breed type; square box shape set off by that slight arch to her neck and her balanced angulation; such structure; such graceful body lines but lacking nothing in functional fitness and power; covers plenty of ground stood with a lithe daisy cutting action BVIB & VG4 2nd Taftazini Laura Abyding of Patterscourt (Mrs and Miss Attwood & Turner) just turned 7 yrs; ex breed type; so feminine with a truly outstanding head with a soft oval eye; so well angulated; correctly deep to the end of her ribbing, good tuckup; the ground exaggerated her being a touch down at pastern and not quite as secure and lithe on the move PBEntries (6,1) 1st Lagopusmoor Black mandala (M & T Dodd and Hayes) 8 m black who absolutley blew me away with her lithe and graceful bodylines coupled with her low daisy cutting action that was so textbook correct and such an unbelievable joy to watch as she gaited; feminine head; dark oval eye that toned well with her coat; correct length to her muzzle; short back; well angulated; hope she duly goes onward and upward from this dramatic debut, BPIB & PG3 under the discerning Simon Parsons 2nd Seasham Too Much Heaven (Mrs s & Mr K Peebles) 8 m and so very typy that I can now see was indeed bred in the purple; clean cut head with well set & used ears; correctly short, level, square & deep; so well made overall on such quality body lines; currently just that tad wider in front; plenty of scope in her freedom of movement; must have an assured future 3rd Valger Tiggywinkle (Mr J R & Mrs V Mann) PB (4)1st Seasham How Deep is Your Love (Miss L Wilson) I love it when I'm the only one here not knowing the connection as here stood the 8 m litter sister of Too Much Heaven; such a quality pup with an obvious future; clean cut both in head and in outline; correct proportions whether in head or

body; arch to neck; short in back; depth to width; slope to croup; tuckup at loin; so sound; gaited so readily on ex bone and feet; the dozen puppy class exhibits showed the breed to be in a strong place 2nd Seasham Too Much Heaven 3rd Pelenrise Blow Me A Kiss from Oakbarrow (Mrs D and Mr S Smillie-Gray & Gray) JB (4)1st Tequesta Happy Valley (Mrs D Elrington) litter sister of YD; she was of classic breed type as I now see is Ft Ch sired out of a Ch Barleyarch Dam hence such a fit and functional look combined with grace of outline; lovely headed; arch to neck all the angles; square box look already; no undue width through muscled rear, low lithe gait looks potentially title bound 2nd Richtaig Razzle Me Pink (Miss A Vidamour) 3rd Aytee Quince (Mrs Tanya Mingo) YB (2)1st Keigame Hearts Desire of Sparkenhoe AI (Mrs L Angus) 21 m; quality; ex type and shape with classic, grace of outline; bodylines; clean cut, expressing, head & eye; so well angulated fore & aft; neck has arch; short back; good length of rib with tuck up at loin; good bone; ground covering gait; must have an assured future 2nd Newtonbriar Pur Bliss (Mr N & Mrs W Powell & Tarrant) 20m; striking in head and muzzle; deep through her well muscled, well angulated & well ribbed body; short back; correct breadth through rear; overall of a heavier built type and came on a little slack in front but is barely out of her teens so as to experience those growing "spurts" NB (3) 1st Seasham Too Much Heaven (Mrs s & Mr K Peebles) 2nd Pelenrise Blow Me A Kiss from Oakbarrow (Mrs D & Mr S Smillie-Gray & Gray) 10m, 3rd in PB; shows plenty of promise; just that bit "raw" as yet being a tad tall & long in her appearance; very nice head & eye; cleanest of fronts; deep through to ex tuck up; plenty of angulation; short coat, lithe & straight on the move with a smoothly produced gait 3rd Kenzduo Lilac Spring (Dr H-M Chidwick) PGB (2) 1st No More Cloudy Days (Miss A Atkins) just turned 2 yrs, scored in head with her soft eye and well set & carried ear; slight neck arch well angulated with balance fore & aft; deep through to marked tuck up at loin; short back; broad in rear with slight slope to group; graceful & smooth gait; she should live up to her name with additional maturity so as to move up the ranks 2nd Kenzduo Lilac Spring (Dr H_-M Chidwick) 2 yrs; stood 3rd in NB; here was a novice exhibitor & I see she was duly entered in 6 classes, exactly what I did at my 1st Ch. Show in 1970; such a feminine bitch with grace of outline and clean cut in head; functionally fit & well angulated; just that tad long & loose in her development at this stage; hope they will be back as a team. LB (6) 1st Sperant Chocolate Cosmos JW (Miss L E Merritt) 2.5 yrs absolute classic quality lines; clean cut head excelling in eye & ear as well; has breadth of skull & strength of muzzle; short deep; glorious to watch on the movebeing not only sound on the out & back but with textbook long, daisy cutting action so as to cover the ground; looked of CC quality on this performance 2nd Jomeel Olivia's Choice (Mr M A & Ms C Staley) 2 yrs of ex breed type; ultra feminine with the cleanest of heads; ex muzzle; short back; well ribbed back in body with depth; good bone; well angulated; well muscled; just a tad wide coming on but broad and powerful in rear so as to cover the ground so readily as she gaited; another I can see challenging for Ccs3rd Winterwell Little Itch (Miss K Bunker) OB (8,1) 1 Amazing quality with two Chs in the top four 1st Ankerwycke Silk Stockings (Mrs L,Mr I & Mr F Elliott) 4.5 Yrs; took my breath away as here stood all I had been taught as being classic breed type, combining functionality with grace of outline, standing over plenty og ground yet with a short back & square box shape; Soft eye, soft open nostrils, ex muzzle, arch to neck, deep without width, clean front; hands breadth behind elbow to keep upper arm free; slope to croup; broad rear; long, low, daisy cutting action with some single tracking convergence at speed; you could her a pin drop in the challenge but how you raised the tent roof as she took the Bitch CC then BOB, look forward to her Title 2nd Sperant Pamplemousse (Miss L E Merritt) 5 yrs Dam of the LB that says it all and they are like mirror images; made her a touch wide at elbow so as to be nitpicking here; clean headed; shortbacked; deep; angulated; covers the ground whether static or gaing on good bone and feet; short coat; broad muscled rear; quite simply fabulous & deserving of a Title as marked by RBCC 3rd Sh Ch Winterwell Thatildo for desjiem JW (Ms A & Mr C Brown & Filby)
