My first CC appointment in this breed, which I really enjoyed, thank you to all the exhibitors for entering and accepting my decisions. In some of the lower classes there are some larger dogs creeping in but in the higher classes dogs were of a more uniform size which was good to see. Temperaments were excellent and general balance and construction good.

PD (6,1) 1 Seasham Jingle Jangle (Cooke & Hammond) Promising puppy of medium size, presented a balanced picture both standing and on the move. Everything in the right place with good angles front and rear. BP 2 Jomeel Pulp Fiction (Webster) Another nice puppy presenting a good shape, liked his head shape and expression, nicely muscled. Mistcapel Storm Shadow (Edlin)

JD (4) 1 Tequesta Poldark JW (Adams) Pleasing head with strong neck, parallel front and rear with tight elbows, liked his size, and presented a balanced picture on the move, won on maturity. 2 Jomeel Pulp Fiction (Webster) 2nd in puppy 3 Mistcapel Storm Shadow (Edlin)

YD (1) 1 Sarscottah Easy Ryder at Rollenwood (Rymer) Needs to mature and fill out a little, but liked his size, liked his shoulder placement and strong neck, nicely up on his pasterns. Good rear angulation which he used well on the move.

LD (6,2) 1 Pinseeker Pep Guardiola JW (Heath & Robinson) Really liked this dog standing, medium sized, nice shape with such balance and good proportions, well-muscled all round with particular strong neck, nice and parallel front and rear and strong tight front. 2 Fraulynzway Lightning Bolt JW (Russell) A little larger than I would normally go for but all in proportion, liked his head with strong neck, strong in front with level top line which he held well on the move. 3 Keigame Hvitserk of Sparkenhoe (Angus)

OD (11,3) What a class, really nice, placings could easily change. A difficult decision between the first 3. 1 Ch Quintana Diamond Dust at Friarsbelle JW ShCEx OSW (Dymond) A lot to like about this boy, balance and proportions are all good, good muscle with strong rear end used to advantage with his driving rear action. Everything is in the right place really fit for function. CC & BoB 2 Sh Ch Winterwell Maida Stone (Smith & Reardon) Another nice sized dog, close decision with 3. Everything in proportion with correct angles front and rear, presented a balanced picture on the move. RCC 3 Sh Ch Winterwell Iggy Inch JW (Bowler)

VD (2) 1 Sh Ch Bryburn Bacchus JW ShCM ShCEx (Thurm) 8 yr old well balanced dog that looks as though he could really do a days work. Parallel front and rear with tight elbows and good level top line and moderate tuck up. Moved positively with rear drive. BV 2 Sh Ch Taftazini Aiden Abbett (Pingault) Another nice one with a little more tuck up than I prefer, but a worthy champion with good top line, strong in front, liked him on the move.

Special Beginners Dog (2) 1 Sperant Hibou of Komikhund (Evans-Yarwood) Liked his head, presented an overall good shape but would really like to see a little less of him. BSB. 2 Tuptonsett Master Dexter (Beresford) Heavier build than 1. Parallel straight front with elbows to chest and nice strong neck. Another one to see a little less of.

GCDSD 1 Fraulynzway Lightning Bolt JW (Russell) Good shape, nice balance nice on the move, well up on size. 2 Tuptonsett Master Dexter (Beresford) 2nd in special beginners

PB (5,1) 1 All different sizes but generally good. 1 Seasham Too Much Heaven (Peebles) Litter sister to my puppy dog winner. Pretty girl looking the part standing. Good rear angulation used well on the move. Parallel and tight front. Everything looks good at the moment. 2 Valger Tiggywinkle (Mann) Good size although the largest in the class was correct. Well-proportioned with good rear angulation. Just preferred the movement of 1 as she had a tendency to hunch up a little, but it was cold. 3 Seasham How Deep Is Your Love (Wilson)

JB (3) 1 Soellis Feral Beryl JW (Ellis) Liked her size, has good proportions with balance. Liked her head, strong neck, good level top line with a strong muscled rear end with good angulation. Driving action on the move. 2 Tequesta Happy Valley (Elrington) Similar comments to 1. Good clean neck, parallel front and rear, liked her rear angulation but not driving like 1. Moderate tuck up 3 Seasham How Deep Is Your Love (Wilson)

YB (1) 1 Keigame Hearts Desire of Sparkenhoe (ai) JW (Angus) Alone but worthy winner. Good front, liked her head with strong arched neck, nice and parallel front and rear with moderate tuck up, slightly coarse coat.

GB (2,1) 1 Graygees Tsarine (Edlin) Nice standing with pleasing head. Nice and parallel with good rear angulation. Shows good balance standing and has good proportions. Not giving her all on the move. LB (9) 1 Jomeel Olivia's Choice (Staley) Very balanced bitch of good proportions, liked her size, good front construction, nicely muscled with moderate tuck up and powerful rear end.

2 Winterwell Stoney Trail (Jowsey) Similar comments to 1, liked her head with strong neck and good front construction. 3 Winterwell Little Itch at Karitagan (Bunker)

OB (10,3) An excellent class, placings could easily change. 1 Ch Quintana Lunar Eclipse (Nixon) I have done well for this girl before when a puppy, pleased to see she is now a champion, well deserved, my opinions of her have not changed. Lovely size, everything in moderation. Good head with brains not just for showing. Parallel front and rear with good rear angulation, moderate tuck up and level top line which she held well on the move. CC 2 Sh Ch Dappledele First Date at Bryburn (Thurm) Another nice one, again all in moderation. Loved her size and construction, neat front with good top line and strong rear end used to advantage on the move, really fit for function. RCC 3 Sh Ch Fayemm Treacle Tart with Winterwell JW (ai) (Trow)

VB (2,1) 1 Sh Ch Taftazini Honour Wynna JW (Squire) 7 year old, nice size, with good rear angulation, moderate tuck up and good and parallel front and rear. Enjoying her day out, I don't think she realises she is a veteran.
