SBD (2) 1 Edlins Mistcapel Storm Shadow. Pleasing head, chest well down and good angulation to rear, stood over plenty of ground, BSpB.

VD 1(0) 1 Adams Sh Ch. Barleyarch Ariat JW. Looking fit for his 9 years, excellent head with good width and depth of muzzle, good arch of neck into strong shoulders, so well balanced.

MPD 3(2) 1 Smiths Venatur Forest. Very deserving of his first place, loved this 7 month old boy, solid liver, masculine head of good type and proportions with kind eye, everything coming together for such a youngster, rolling movement only to be expected for a baby, BPD & BP.

PD 3(0) 1 Smiths Venatur Forest. Repeat. 2. Rusks Valger Tuxedo at Booton. Nicely balanced young dog, good head shape with soft expression, plenty of bone, good top-line into correct tail set, just needs more confidence on the move. 3. Hammond/Cookes Seasham Jingle Jangle.

JD 8(2) 1 Adams Tequesta Poldark JW. Impressive young dog with pleasing head, short back and covering the ground, quality coat, BJ & Junior Group 1 - congrats. 2. Evans-Yarwood/Yarwoods Sperant Hibou of Komikhund. Well shaped head with kind eye, maturing well, nicely held top-line on the move, will do well in the future. 3. Bunkers Mistcapel Blowin The Breeze.

GD 6(2) 1 Evans-Yarwood/Yarwoods Sperant Hibou of Komikhund. Repeat. 2. Desombres Braneath Peregrine. Balanced outline, presented himself well, desirable head, good body length, possessing plenty of bone and adequate angulation. 3. Rymers Sarscottah Easy Ryder at Rollenwood JW.

PGD 4(0) 1 Mapes Agdenusher Mulberry. Good foreface, shape of muzzle and sweet expression, nicely arched neck, not overdone, well balanced front with legs well under, moved freely. 2. McCaffertys Thorscrag Hades JW. A well built, balanced boy with good bone and front assembly, correct coarse coat. 3. McMurdo/Tierneys Ceilloch Express.

LD 7(0) 1 Heath/Robinsons Pinseeker Pep Guardiola JW. This fellow stood solid as a rock and sold himself effortlessly, beautiful head, strong medium length of neck into well angled shoulders, level top-line, sloping gently to well set on tail, showing good muscle tone and 2nd thigh, moved with drive, looked in super fit condition today, DCC. 2. Taylor/Taylor-Morris Pelenrise All Guns Blazing JW. Another super boy, nothing overdone, of smaller stature than 1 but balanced throughout, good feet and correct coat. 3. Serpa/Grahams Winterwell Tubby Tompkin from Nyliram JW.

OD 10(0) What a superb class this was. 1. Peebles/Hammonds Seasham The Groover. Beautiful l/w dog, impressive appearance both stacked and on the move, head type so appealing with melting expression, conformation not lacking in any department, RDCC. 2. Marshs Kilnrae Berliner. Excellent head shape, good eye and ears, strong hindquarters, good angulation, powerful when moving, keeping steady top-line. 3. Smith/Reardons Sh Ch. Winterwell Maida Stone.

VB 2(0) 1 Malins Sh Ch. Keigame Murphlette at Benrae VW. Very stylish 8 year old, looking in peak condition, classic head with super dark eye, good forefront and correct depth of chest, well angulated and toned, moved with accuracy, BV & Veteran Group 3 - well done. 2. Pearsons Sh Ch. Ladyhawke Dizzy Miss Lizzy. Flashy l/w 7 year old, well balanced throughout, a little finer than my winner, moved out well and looking in great condition.

MPB 5(0) 1 Brudenell-Pryke/Gallaghers Venatur Indicus. Solid liver and litter sister to my dog puppy winner, has similar attributes, delightful in head with broad, deep muzzle and retaining her femininity. 2. Hammond/Cookes

Seasham Kiss Me. Another sweet feminine head, good front and rear angulation, very well balanced for one so young, confident on the move. 3. Keys Orchidstar Time To Chime.

PB 7(1) 1 Manns Valger Tiggywinkle. What a lovely young bitch, proportionate, balanced head with soft eye, pleasing front assembly with strong forearm, maturing well, excellent coat texture, looked to be enjoying her time in the show-ring. BPB. 2 Brudenell-Pryke/Gallagher's Venatur Indicus. Repeat. 3. Peebles Seasham Too Much Heaven.

JB 3(1) 1. Sielskis Orchidstar Silver Lightnin. Beautiful head, arching neck into good shoulders, balanced all through, harsh coat, good feet. 2. Brown's Montalba Miss Aching. Flashy girl, lovely facial expression, nicely balanced with correct top-line and tail set.

GB 3(0) 1. Smillie-Gray/Gray's Pelenrise Blow Me A Kiss from Oakberrow. Balanced head with pleasing muzzle shape and depth, short back, strong legs with good bone, free action on the move placing good feet. 2. Wilsons Seasham How Deep Is Your Love. Another nice bitch, of different type to 1, well balanced, dark in colour and correct coat, moved out well. 3. Browns Montalba Miss Aching.

PGB 2(0) 1. Merritts Sperant Chocolate Cosmos JW. Very well put together, balanced and of good breed type, pretty head with dark eye, good angulation fore and aft, level top-line, smooth action on the move. 2. Browns Montalba Miss Aching. Repeat.

LB 12(1) A quality class, I was spoilt for choice. 1. Gatcliffe's Allezweck Edessa. Super head of ideal length and depth of muzzle, well made front and good angulation, presented today in excellent condition, good reach and placement of feet when moving. 2. Jowsey's Winterwell Stoney Trail. Feminine bitch of excellent breed type, chest well down to elbow, plenty of bone, good angles and width of thigh, moved well. 3. Bunkers Winterwell Little Itch at Karitagan.

OB 8(2) What a stunning class, so pleasing to see such a grand line up. 1. Filby/Brown's Sh Ch. Winterwell Thatllo for Desjiem JW. Eye-catching girl, now in her prime, short coupled with excellent top-line and tail set, best of heads with soft expression, well developed rear, standing on good hocks, tight neat feet, in superb condition, loved and showed herself extremely well, BCC & BOB. 2. Hammond/Cooke's Sh Ch. Seasham I Love To Boogie. Another quality bitch, feminine, proportionate head with gorgeous eye, correct length of neck, good front and standing over good ground, striding out on the move, RBCC. 3. Elliotts Ankerwycke Silk Stockings.

GCB 2(1) 1. Whitehouses Kazanpaul Prawn Cracker. Stood alone but worthy of her placing, a sweet girl of smaller stamp, has the loveliest of heads, balanced throughout, correct in coat and a sound mover.
